SANDAKAN: Rukun Tetangga (KRT) areas throughout Sabah are encouraged to continue their activities amidst the relaxation brought on by the transition to endemic phase, which began on April 1.

National Unity and Integration Department Sabah Director Delin Liet Blaun said she appreciated the contributions of KRT members during the pandemic.

She said there are currently 1,058 KRTs in Sabah involved in the Rukun Tetangga Leadership Empowerment Plan which has five cores.
